

Argo's Mission

Provide boaters with an easy-to-use navigation app for iOS and Android mobile devices with a wide range of features to improve boaters' experience and safety.



A born explorer, Jeff grew up boating on the Chesapeake Bay where he enjoyed discovering the bay's many inlets and coves and spending nights out on the water in his 22' Grady White. He loved doing anything outdoors – kayaking, hiking, competing in triathlons. After getting married, exploring continued as he looked for places

to swim with his kids or relax at a good waterside restaurant or dock bar.

With a University of Delaware degree in Mechanical and

Aerospace Engineering in hand, he went to work for his family-owned defense company and has been CEO since 2011. But he continued to dream of exploring the water around him. Although many apps existed for navigation and social sharing on land, he was consumed by the idea of creating something just for boaters to navigate and connect on the water. He wanted to be able to plan a boat trip the same way he planned a road trip—with an easy to use app on his phone. He was working with crowd sourcing in his defense company and he thought if he could harness that concept to help boaters, he could offer an easier way to find and get places on the water without relying on word of mouth.

In November 2018 he set out to develop an app with the support of an experienced development

team in Baltimore, Maryland. The goal: help boaters plan their next trip, plot a safe course, get tips from other boaters and share adventures with friends. In addition to navigation, one of his priorities was making the app community-focused, allowing boaters to share information about weather conditions and potential hazards. Another priority was making the initial release free to enable easy access for those boaters who don't have expensive GPS systems.

Given his quest to explore the water and be the

first to link like-minded boaters, Foulk decided to name the app Argo after the first ship to sail the seas. In Greek mythology, the Argo was constructed

by the shipwright Argus with the help of Athena.

The app was released in September 2019 to immediate positive reviews. Until Argo, there had been no single app to combine marine navigation with social boating functionality. The team continues to add new features and update it based on user feedback and the app continues to grow in popularity. Today it has 300,000 downloads along east and west coasts, Great Lakes, and numerous inland lakes and rivers throughout the U.S. and Canada.

In addition to founding Argo and being an avid boater, Jeff continues as full-time CEO and volunteers with many community organizations. He and his wife have plans to upgrade to a larger boat in a few years and explore the Great Loop which he views as the ultimate adventure.



Jeff's Background

In addition to founding Argo, Jeff Foulk is Chief Executive Officer of the SURVICE Engineering Company and a 1982 graduate of the University of Delaware with a degree in Mechanical and Aerospace Engineering. He furthered his education at the Von Karman Institute for Fluid Dynamics in Belgium and received an advanced degree in Aeronautics and Aerospace in 1983.

After earning his degree, Jeff joined SURVICE, a family-owned business that his father Jim Foulk started in 1981. SURVICE supports and protects the U.S. warfighter with unparalleled survivability

services (hence the name "SURVICE"). Mr. Foulk helped grow the business from his parents' basement to one that

now employees over 350 employees at 12 locations across the country. "Mr. Foulk—along with SURVICE's CFO Dottie Bowser—was recognized in 2012 as one of *The Baltimore Business Journal's* CEO/CFO Dream Teams and in 2021 like his father was recognized as NMTC Visionary of the Year."

As CEO, Jeff is responsible for the vision, management, and strategic development of the company. While SURVICE has retained the original vision upon which the company was founded—to provide the Warfighter with the safest, most survivable, and most effective equipment—they also support Homeland



Security, advanced technologies, environmental, and commercial markets. Recently they opened a new Drone Research Facility at the Harford Airport in Churchville to support the development and testing of the latest in unmanned platforms. Over the years SURVICE has developed a reputation not only for advanced technologies but also a place that their employees are proud to work. Over the past decade, they have been recognized numerous times as a Top Work Place.

In 2018, Jeff began development on a mobile app and crowdsourcing solutions for the boating

community; and in 2019 he formally launched Argo Navigation LLC. Later that year he released a free boating

app, Argo, giving boaters the ability to route to new destinations, share local knowledge, and connect with other boaters.

Jeff is also actively involved with numerous community and philanthropic efforts supporting youth education and veteran causes.





FAQs

Q. Is Argo really free?

A. Yes, Argo is FREE to download and FREE to use! Boaters that choose to upgrade to the Premium version get all our FREE features plus offline charts, extended weather, wind, tides and more.

Q. What devices can I use with the app?
A. Argo is compatible with both Apple iOS and
Android phones, and works on iPad or Android tablet
devices.

Q. Do I need to register when I download the app?
A. You do not need to register to download the app, however we recommend you sign in and set up your Argo Profile with your boat details to take full advantage of our app features and for safer navigation.

Q. Is it easy to upgrade to Premium? Yes, just tap the icon, found in the top right corner of Argo's Home Screen, and choose Unlock Premium Features.

Q. How does social boating work?

A. Argo's social features let you connect with friends on the water without having to tell the entire world where you are like traditional social apps do. You can sync with your Facebook friends and phone contacts so you control who sees where you are. Plus:

- Search for Friends find boaters you may know on Argo with new search capabilities by affiliation (marina or boat club) or with our friend suggestions for people you may know on Argo
- See Friends on the Water see where other Argo users are on the water (with privacy settings)
- Message send other boaters an Ahoy, or message friends to meet-up
- Social Feed share voyages, photos and other updates to friends with Argo's social feed

Q. Where can I find more Argo Peeps?

A. Once you register on our app, you can join our Facebook Group, Argo Boating Community, to extend your boating circle and connect with more Argo app users. Get app tips, learn about new app features, share boating stories and more.

Q. What does the local boating knowledge include?
A. Information you won't find anywhere else, such as:

- Real-Time Reports our crowdsourced local reports from other boaters help you navigate safely with report pins placed around you for hazards in the water, map issues and more.
- Place Details see details for places like fuel, amenities, transient dock info and how to contact. Add places (public or private) that may be missing.
- Local Reviews see reviews and photos from other boaters for local points of interest on or near water
