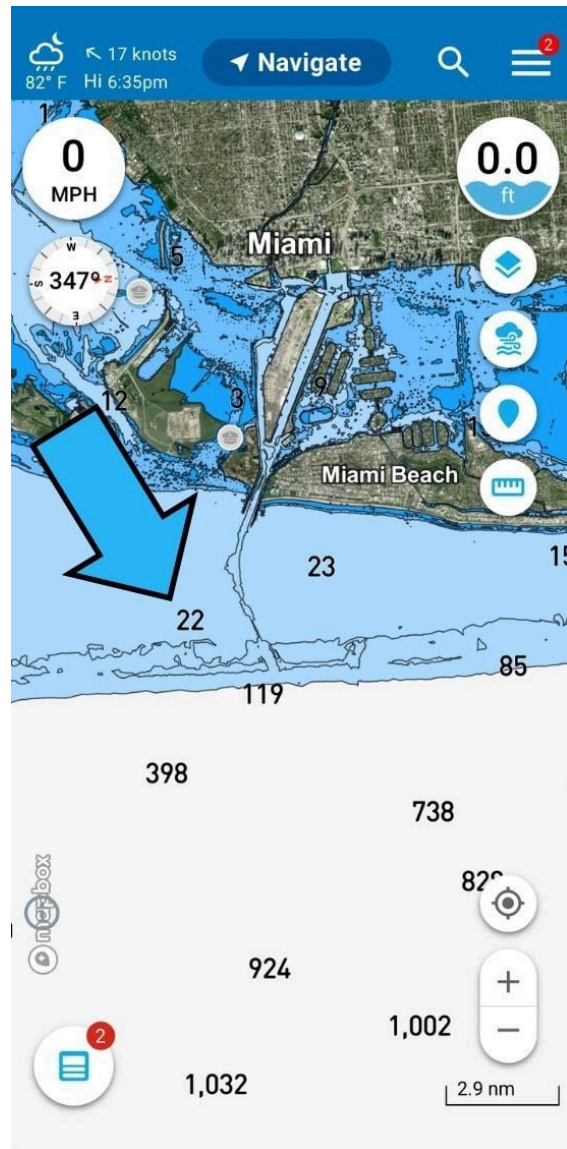
# Depth Numbers Now Stay Upright

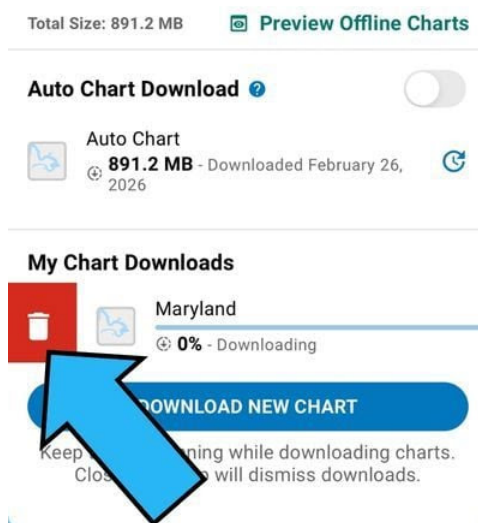

You may have wondered how to discard an offline map while it's still downloading? This is certainly an issue for bigger download sizes, especially with slow internet.

To stop a chart download, you slide the card to the right and hit the red trashcan. This works for both completed and in progress downloads.
