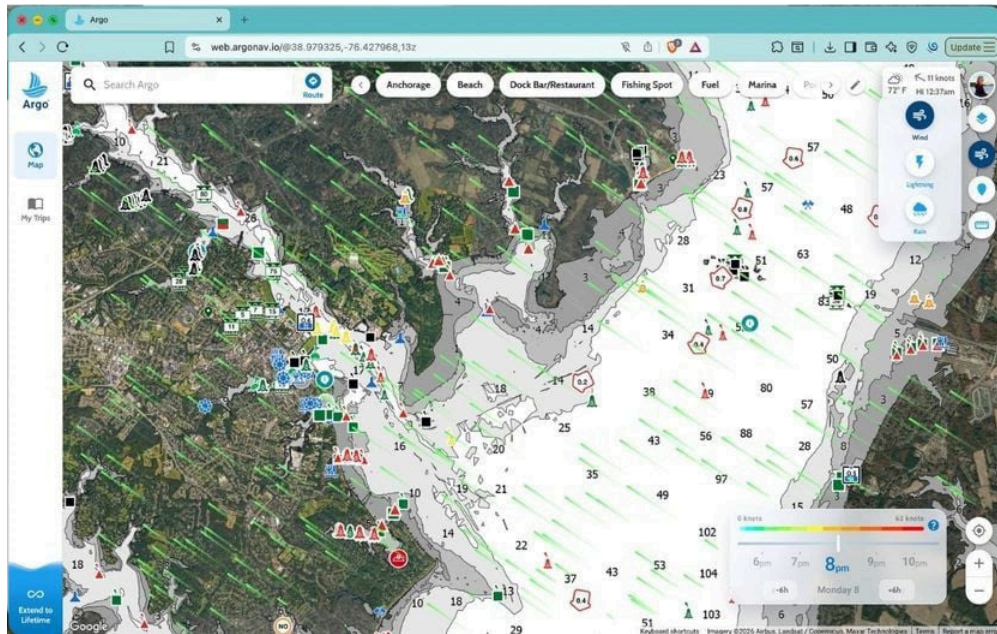

Major Upgrades to the Argo Web App



Web App Release 1.0.60 is live with major upgrades to weather, routing, and navigation tools.

New features include

- Rain and lightning weather layers
- A new weather widget in the top-right corner
- Wind details when long-pressing a map location
- RNC charts now available in map options
- POI sharing and improved track/route info
- Search for navigation aids by name

Plus several bug fixes and usability improvements throughout the app.

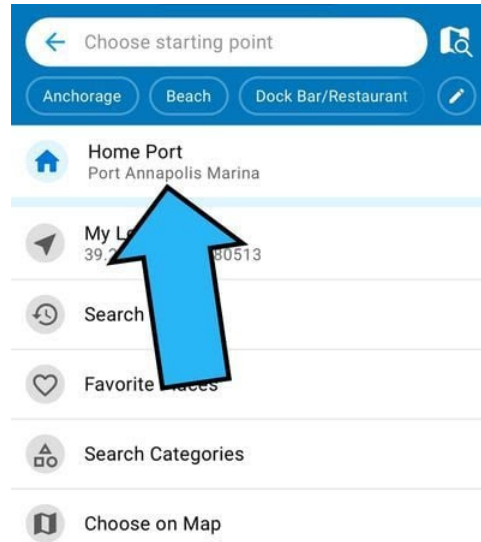

Set Your Home Port Once

Add your Home Port to your boat profile for faster route planning. Your Home Port will appear as a quick-select option when creating routes, saving you from searching for the same location every time.

Go to Settings > Edit Boat Information > Home Port to set it up.
