What's New this Week

Spot Hazards with AI Vision



We've mentioned LOOKOUT before, but this is worth a closer look.

LOOKOUT's AI vision camera scans the water around you and highlights boats, markers, and obstacles in real time. It's like giving your boat a second set of eyes, helping you catch things you might otherwise miss, like a kayaker at dawn.

It's early, but this is where boating tech is headed. Think self-driving cars, but for the water. Today it's awareness. Tomorrow it's assistance.

Now, Argo plugs right into that future. You can send your routes directly into LOOKOUT and follow them in its live camera view, combining smart planning with real-time visual awareness.

Other New Features:

- Added option to reduce points and split files when exporting to GPX for tracks (formerly only available for routes).
 - Some chart downloads were getting stuck at 85%. We've fixed the issue so downloads should happen swiftly again.
 - Added a new toggle to turn all Places and Nav Aids on/off under Map Options. This makes simplifying your chart easier.

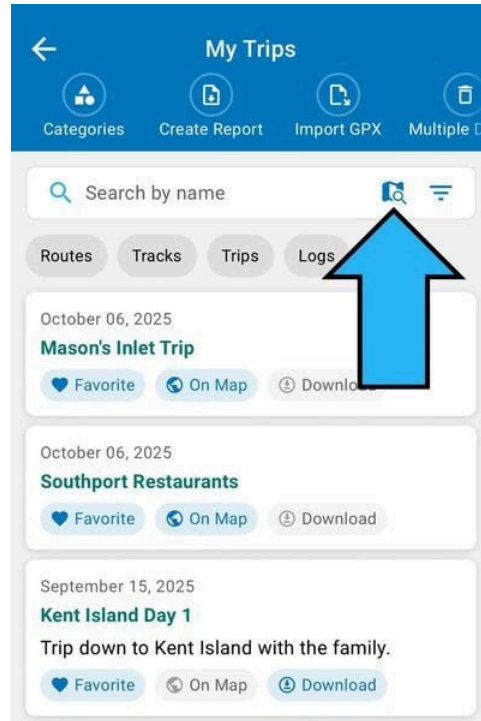
Quick Tip
