## **Bob423 Tracks Are Now in Argo**

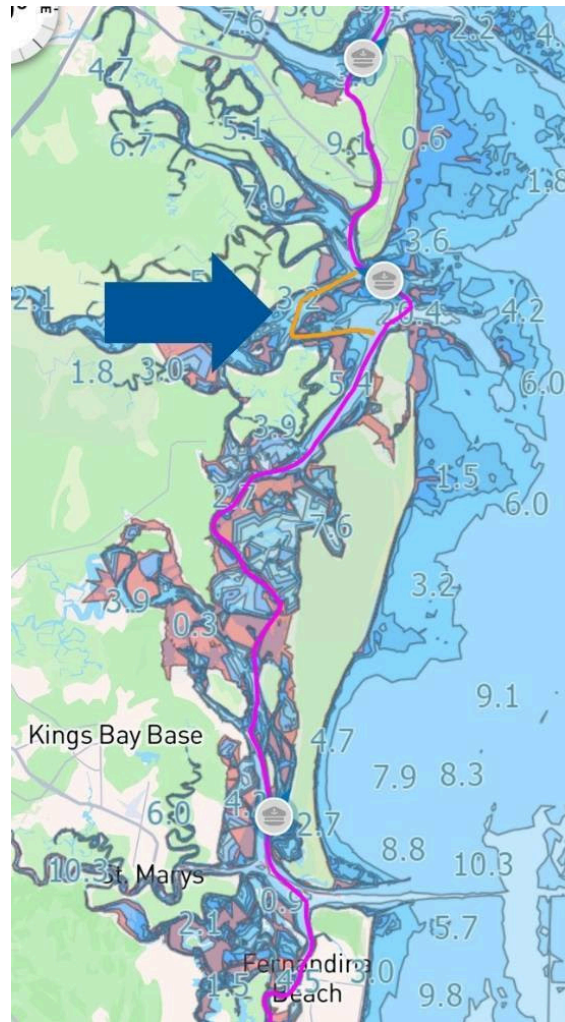
Follow the routes thousands of loopers rely on. Bob423 Tracks are now built right into Argo, no downloads needed.

These are pre-planned routes along the Intracoastal Waterway (ICW) that highlight safer, proven paths like deeper water, known passages, and helpful detours. It's an easy way to navigate with more confidence.

Tracks are updated automatically each week, so you're always seeing the latest routes.

Toggle them on or off anytime in Map Options.

## Quick Tip

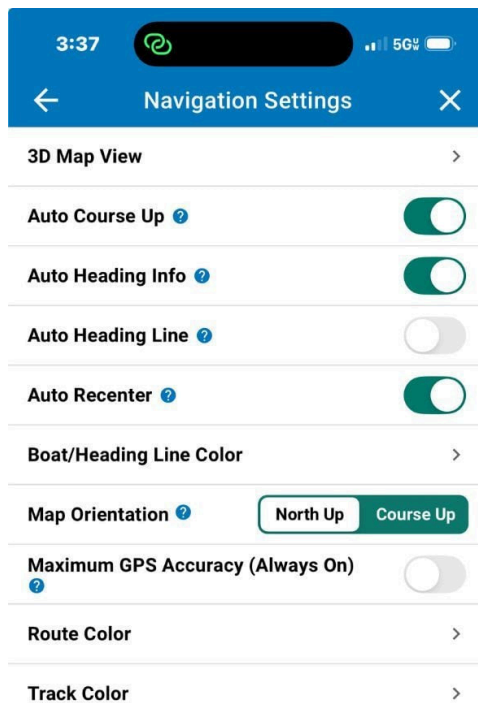
# Customize Your Navigation

Did you know you can customize how your routes and navigation look and behave in Argo?

Head to **Menu** → **Settings** → **Navigation Settings** to fine-tune things like:

- **Auto Course Up** – automatically rotates the map so you're always moving "up" on screen
- **Auto Heading Line** – shows a projected line of where your boat is heading
- **Heading Info** – displays your current heading so you can stay oriented
- **Auto Recenter** – keeps your boat centered on the screen as you move
- **Route and Track Colors** – adjust colors for better visibility at a glance

These small tweaks can make a big difference, whether you want a cleaner view or more real-time guidance while you're underway.
