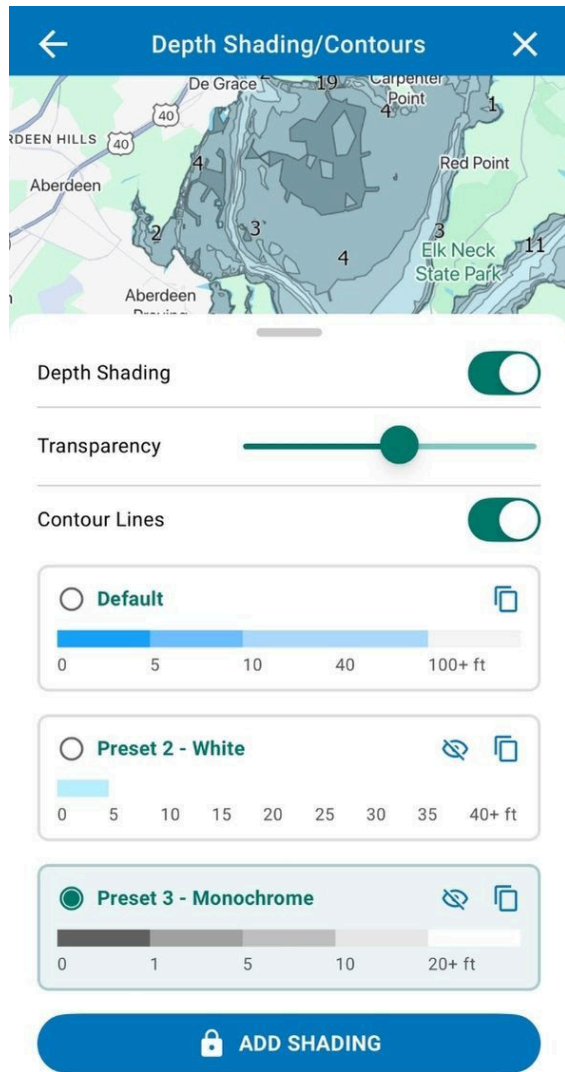
See Clearly in Sun Glare

Sunny days are perfect for boating, but glare can make it hard to see your screen. In the latest Argo update, you can switch your depth shading to two high-contrast presets:

1. Preset 2 - White: Mostly white with shallow areas under 5 feet in light blue, making contour lines and depth numbers easy to read.

2. Preset 3 - Monochrome: All grayscale for full contrast across all depths.

Whichever you choose, bright sun glare won't get in the way of clear, safe, and stress-free navigation.



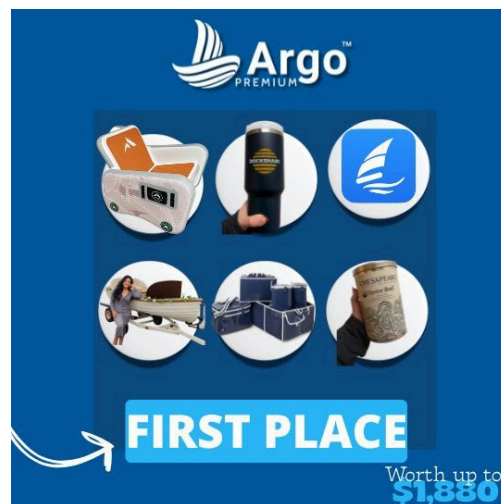

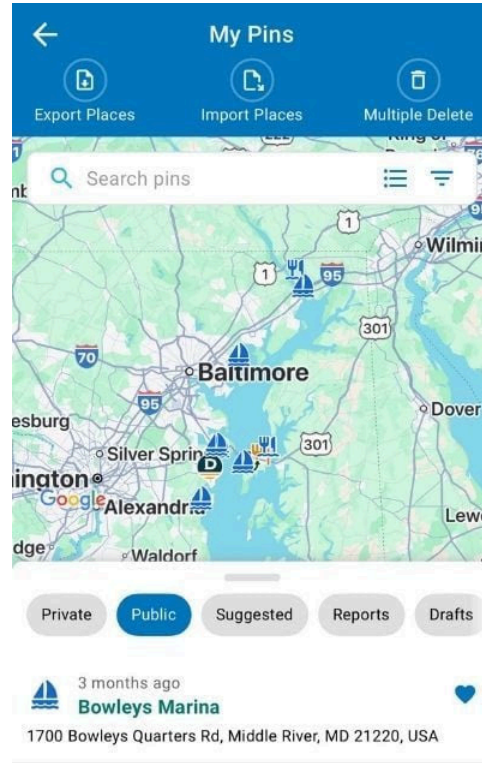
Quick Tip

Did you know you can view and manage every pin you've saved right from the app? Just go to **Settings** → **My Pins**. Here you can:

- See all your saved places, public submissions, report pins, and temporary drafts
- Search through your pins or view them on the chart
- Import or export pins via GPX
- Sort pins by type, date created, or other criteria
