Get creative, have fun, and most importantly, stay safe on the water.

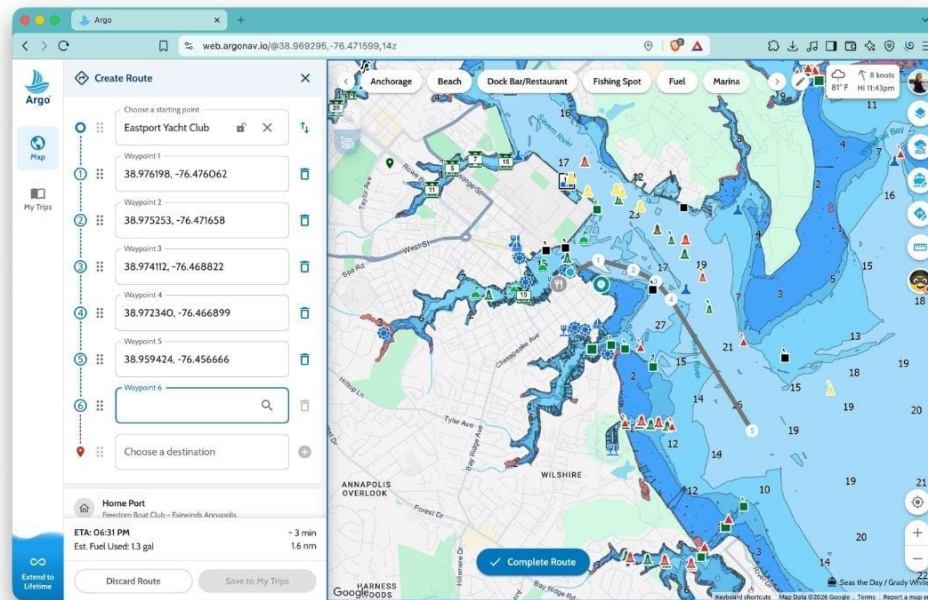

Whale Protection Zones Are Now Easier to See in Argo



Earlier this summer, Transport Canada's Whale Enforcement Unit reached out to Argo with an important question: did the app clearly show the active whale protection zones in southern British Columbia?

The question came from a real issue on the water. Some boaters had entered vessel-restricted or speed-restricted areas and said the zones were not visible in the charting software they were using.

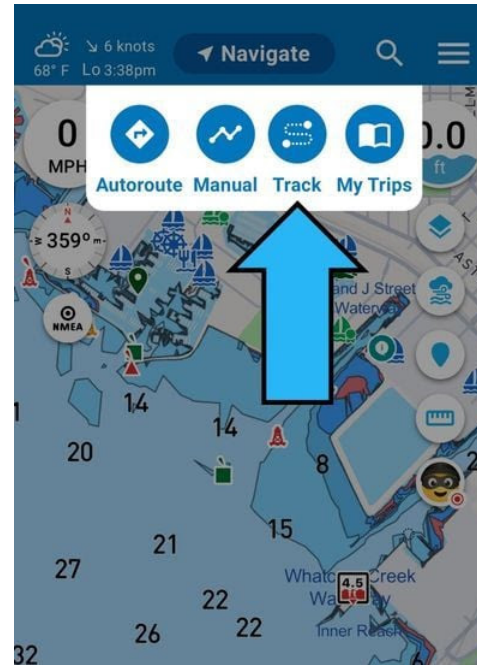
Quick Tip
